Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

Positive relationships are important for life-long learning and success. We use a variety of planned and spontaneous learning opportunities for teaching children how to share, take turns, follow rules and respect each other's difference. Teachers and practitioners are effective role models and offer children strong and supportive relationships which enable children to become confident in learning to recognise their own interests, needs and emotions so they can learn to express themselves effectively.

As well as following the whole school behaviour reward system (Good to be Green), we believe in positive reinforcement. We use a variety of strategies to encourage and reward children who follow our five golden rules. We offer a points system throughout the school. Children earn points for following the golden rules which they can then exchange for prizes. Using this system, children are able to take responsibility for their behaviour and understand the correlation between positive behaviour and positive reinforcement.

Children learn to recognise each other's achievements and are able to support each other as they reach for their goals.
