

# Spring Term Year 4 – End of the World

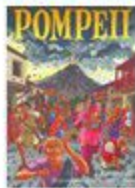
## In English we are learning:

We are learning to write effective stories through the use of picture books. Year 4 are looking at using fronted adverbials followed by a comma and extending our sentences further with a range of conjunctions.

We are also seeing how we can improve our own writing by editing which helps us to see what does a great piece of writing consist of.

## In other subjects we are learning:

## In Maths we are learning:

Year 4 are learning how to effectively solve multiplication and division problems using formal written methods. We are also focussing on knowing our times tables up to 12 x 12 in preparation for our Times Tables Check in the Summer. Another unit we are learning is about fractions. This covers equivalence, fractions of amounts, simplifying and linking this to decimals.

## In Science we are learning:

This term, our topics are sound and animals, including humans. With sound, we are exploring how we hear a sound and where a sound comes from. We are also learning about the inner workings of the ear. In animals, including humans topic, we are learning about our digestive system and the names and functions of each of our teeth.
