

Summer Term Year 1

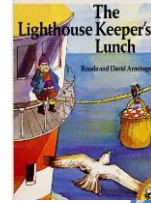
In English we are learning:

- To add 'ed', 'er', 'est' and 'ing' to a basic root word
- To add the prefix 'un' to a word
- To understand and use singular and plural
- To form full stops, question marks and exclamation marks

In other subjects we are learning:

History: Seaside holidays from the past

Geography: Countries in the United Kingdom. The 7 continents and 5 oceans.

Art: Andy Goldsworthy-Spirals and patterns

DT: Stick puppets

Music: Composing and accompanying a song with voice and musical instruments

PE: Balance, co-ordination and methods of travel

In Maths we are learning:

- Multiplication (making equal groups)
- Counting in steps of 2's, 5's and 10's
- Division (sharing equally into groups)
- Halves and quarters of shapes and numbers
- Numbers to 100

In Science we are learning:

- To sort animals into categories (including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals).
- To classify and name animals by what they eat (carnivore, herbivore and omnivore).
- To observe simple changes in weather over time within the four seasons
