

In English we are learning:

Writing: We are retelling stories, writing setting and character descriptions, a diary entry and a newspaper report. We will be learning to:

- use selected adjectives to create variety and add impact and a variety of sentence openers to add interest.
- use prepositions to show position of objects and a variety of conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause.
- use speech appropriately.
- Use paragraphs.

Reading - we are exploring predicting, clarifying, questioning and summarising parts of texts using a range of genres such as narratives, poetry and non-fiction.

In Maths we are learning:

Unit 4 / 5 – Multiplication and Division - solve problems, including missing number problems, involving multiplication and division.

Unit 6 – Money - add and subtract amounts of money to give change, using both £ and p in practical contexts.

Unit 7 – Statistics - interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables.

Unit 8 – Measurement - measure, compare, add and subtract: lengths (m/cm/mm); mass (kg/g); volume/capacity (l/ml) and measure the perimeter of simple 2-D shapes.

Unit 9 – Fractions - count up and down in tenths / recognise tenths.

Recognise unit and non-unit fractions.

In Year 3 we are reading *Llama Aloud* by Annabelle Sami alongside other books by a range of different authors.



In Science we are learning:

Forces and Magnets

- compare how things move on different surfaces.
- notice that some forces need contact between 2 objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance.
- observe how magnets attract or repel each other and attract some materials and not others.
- compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of whether they are attracted to a magnet, and identify some magnetic materials.
- describe magnets as having 2 poles.
- predict whether 2 magnets will attract or repel each other, depending on which poles are facing.
