In English we are learning:

- Setting description of a Blitz scene
- Evacuee narrative
- How to punctuate speech accurately and effectively
- Writing a letter home as an evacuee
- Explanation text on rationing and air raid measures

In class this term, we will be reading *Friend or Foe* by Michael Morpurgo, as well as many other texts by famous authors.

In Maths we are learning:

Pupils will learn to:

- Associate the brightness of a lamp or the volume of a buzzer with the number and voltage of cells used in the circuit
- Compare and give reasons for variations in how components function, including the brightness of bulbs, the loudness of buzzers and the on/off position of switches
- Use recognised symbols when representing a simple circuit in a diagram.
