

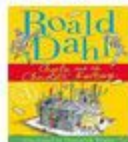
Autumn Term Year 2 - Superheroes

In English we are learning:

- To write for different purposes.
- To use capital letters, full stops, commas in a list, conjunctions, apostrophes and different sentence types in our writing.
- To form lower case letters correctly.
- To use phonics to segment words.
- To sight read common exception words.

Charlie and the Chocolate Factory by Roald Dahl



In other subjects we are learning:

- Art : Sculpture/Drawing
- Music: Pitch/Christmas production singing
- Computing: Creating media/Data handling
- D.T: Moving picture book/Boats
- R.E: Islam/Festivals
- PSHE: Me and my relationships/Valuing differences
- History: Ernest Shackleton, Captain Scott and Titanic
- Geography: Identifying oceans and map work
- P.E: Gymnastics/Invasion games

In Maths we are learning:

- Count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals;
- Count in multiples of twos, fives and tens
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers
- Compare and order numbers from 0 up to 100; use $<$, $>$ and $=$ signs
- Recall and use addition and subtraction facts to 20 fluently, and derive and use related facts up to 100.
- To use column addition and subtraction
- Add three one-digit numbers.
- Recognise and use symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p); combine amounts to make a particular value

In Science we are learning:

- Explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.
- Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs
- Identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats
- Draw a simple food chain.
- identify and compare the suitability of a variety of everyday materials.
- compare how things move on different surfaces.
- find materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching
