<u>EYFS</u>

66% of our children achieved a **GOOD LEVEL OF DEVELOPMENT** (68% Walsall, 72% national)

An increase of 36% from 2018 (4.2% increase from 2017).

Year 1 Phonics Check

60% of our children passed the phonics check (82% Walsall, 82% national)

This is a dip of 4.5% on 2018 and 16.7% dip from 2017.

As a result, we are introducing a new phonics system – RWI, with effect from September 2019.

Trends in KS1:

Reading ARE - 1% dip from 2018, 3% dip from 2017: GDS – 10% increase from 2018 and 2017

Writing ARE -5% rise from 2018, 19% rise since 2017: GDS - 7% rise from 2018, 3% rise from 2017

Maths ARE - 12% rise from 2018, no change from 2017: GDS - 3% rise from 2018, no change from 2017

RWM combined – ARE – school 65% (National 65%) : GDS school 3% (National 11%)

Reading – ARE 18% rise from 2018, 3% rise from 2017: GD - 9% rise from 2018, 1% rise from 2017

Writing – ARE 11% rise since 2018, 12% rise from 2017: GD - 5% rise from 2018, 15% rise from 2017

Maths - ARE 18% rise since 2018, 19% rise from 2017: GD - 6% dip from 2018, 11% rise from 2017

GPS - ARE 12% increase from 2018, no change from 2017: GD – 5% rise since 2018, 9% rise from 2017

Combined - ARE - 17% rise since 2018, 11% rise from 2017: GD – 3% dip from 2018, 7% rise from 2017
